March 10th: KC Trivia Night. Still looking for someone to co-chair this event with the Grand Knight Dave

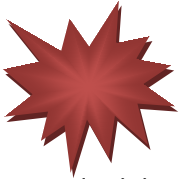

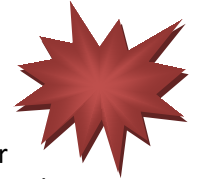
